Appointment of Water Filtration Leadperson – Mayor Moore said he is not ready to make a recommendation for this position at this time.

Presentation and Discussion Concerning Water Rate Study – Shannon Woodard with Connor & Connor Engineering completed the water and sewer rate study and presented his findings to the

Council. The City is currently losing money as the expenses far exceed the revenues in both water and sewer. Mayor Moore has asked both the water committee and finance committee to meet and develop and plan to remedy this problem.

Ordinance Amending the Code Concerning Cemetery Fees – This topic was discussed at a previous meeting. This ordinance will increase the fees for grave openings on Saturdays, holidays, and before noon on the next business day following a weekend or city holiday to \$600.00. It also prohibits grave openings on Sundays and after noon on Saturdays. A motion was made by Alderman Sheryl Eckleberry, seconded by Alderman McKibben to approve this ordinance.

Update Concerning the Solar Eclipse and Activities – Libby Lingafelter gave an update concerning activities and events that she and the recreation committee have planned for the upcoming solar eclipse. The area is expecting large crowds for this event.

Miscellaneous – Mayor Moore informed the Council that Governor JB Pritzker is proposing to eliminate the 1% sales tax on groceries, which is dedicated for local governments in Illinois. This proposed elimination would cut approximately \$325 million from municipalities at a time when local governments are facing more unfunded mandates and rising pension costs. The Illinois Municipal League is encouraging municipal officials to contact their State Representative and State Senator to voice opposition to this massive revenue reduction that will negatively impact all municipalities.
